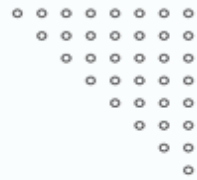

- ▶ It is a present condition but with a forward reference.





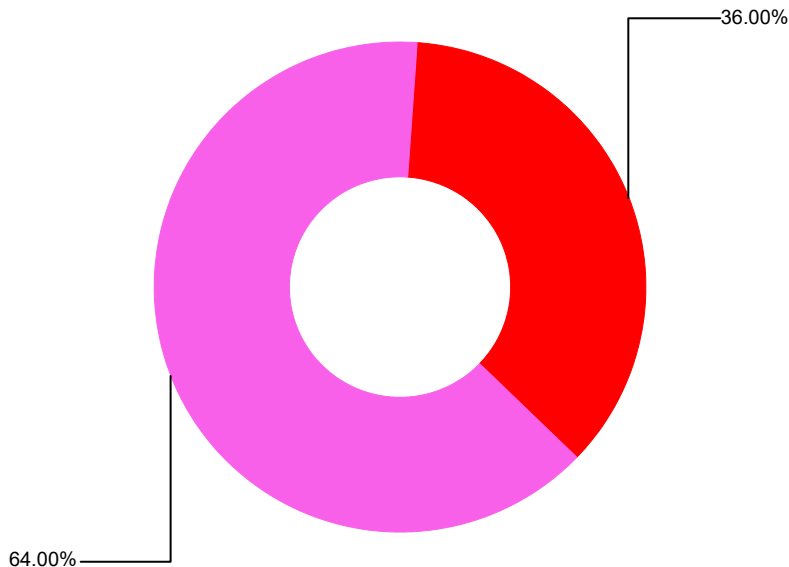
SPECIALITY IN OUR TEST

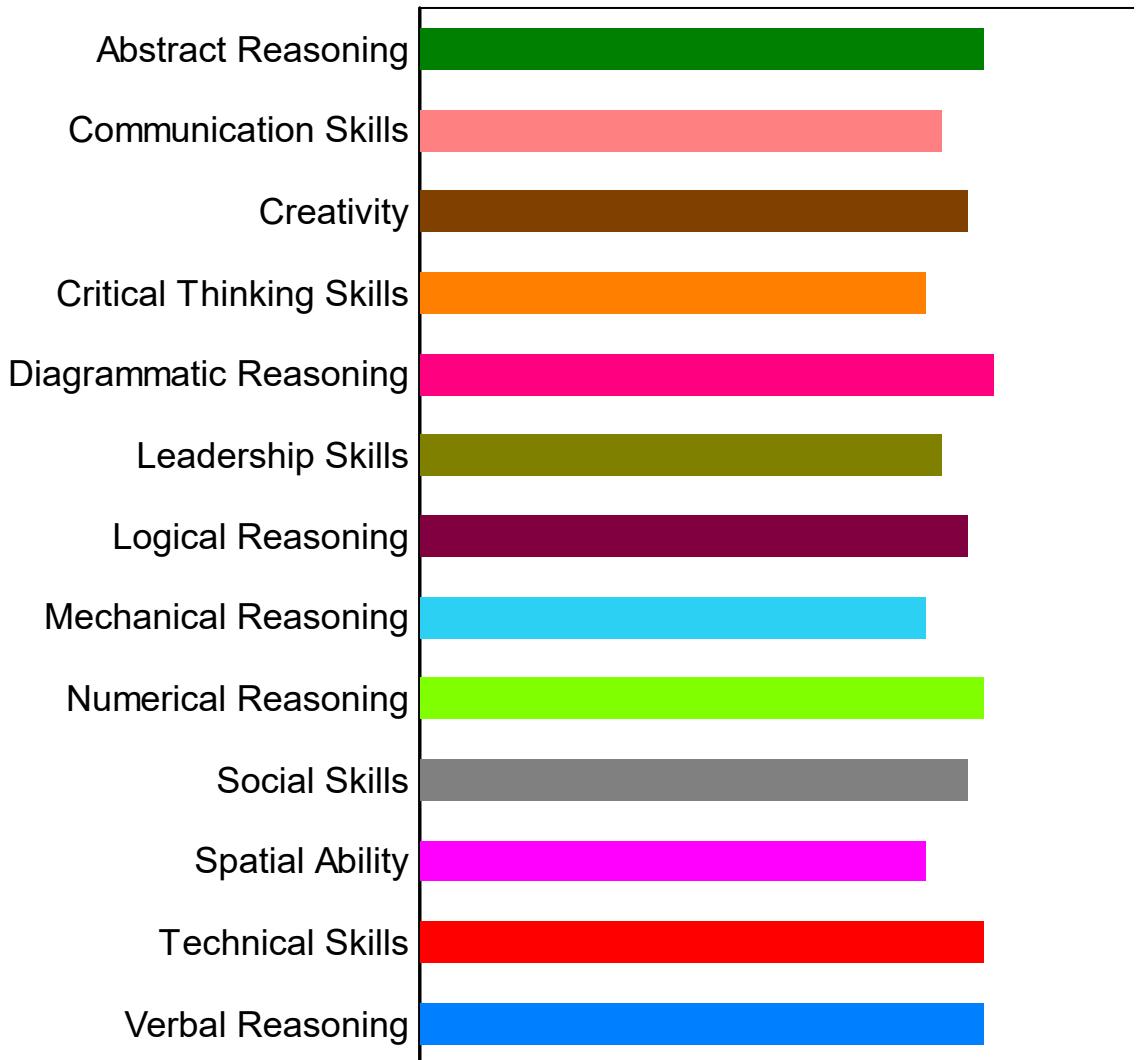

OVERALL SCORE OF APTITUDE

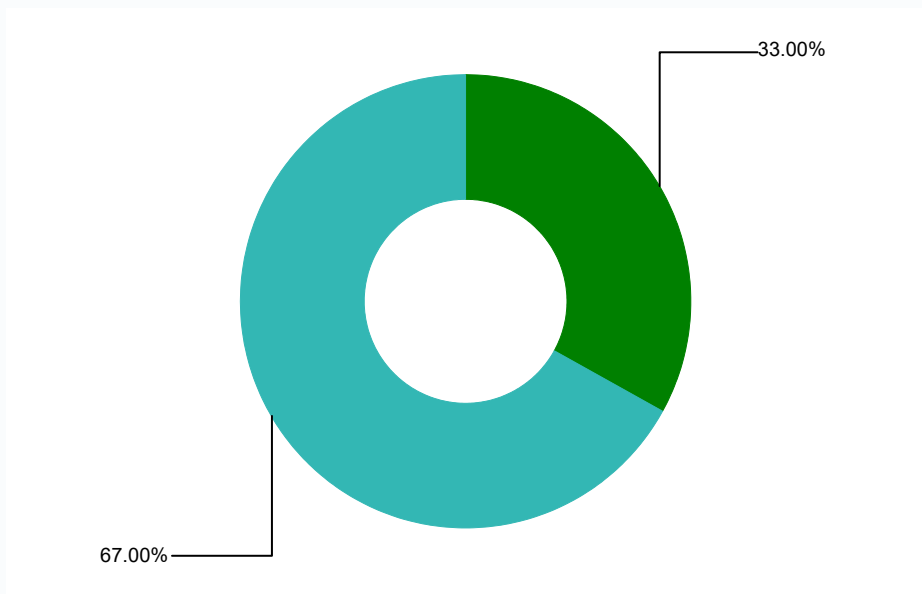

OVERALL SCORING AND THE AREAS

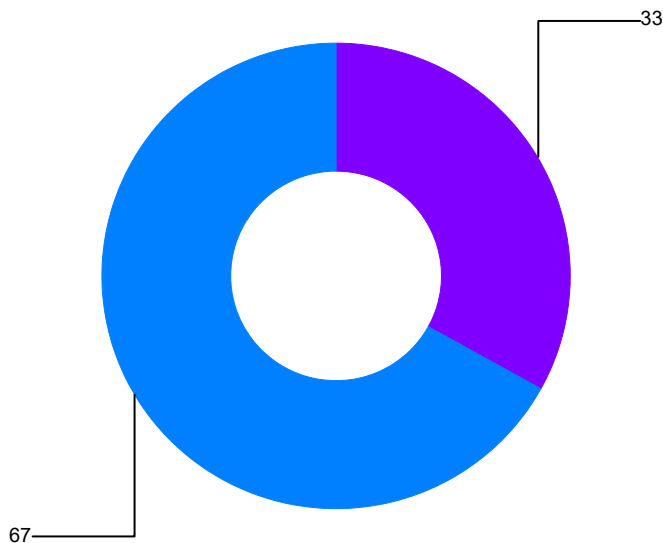


NUMERICAL REASONING



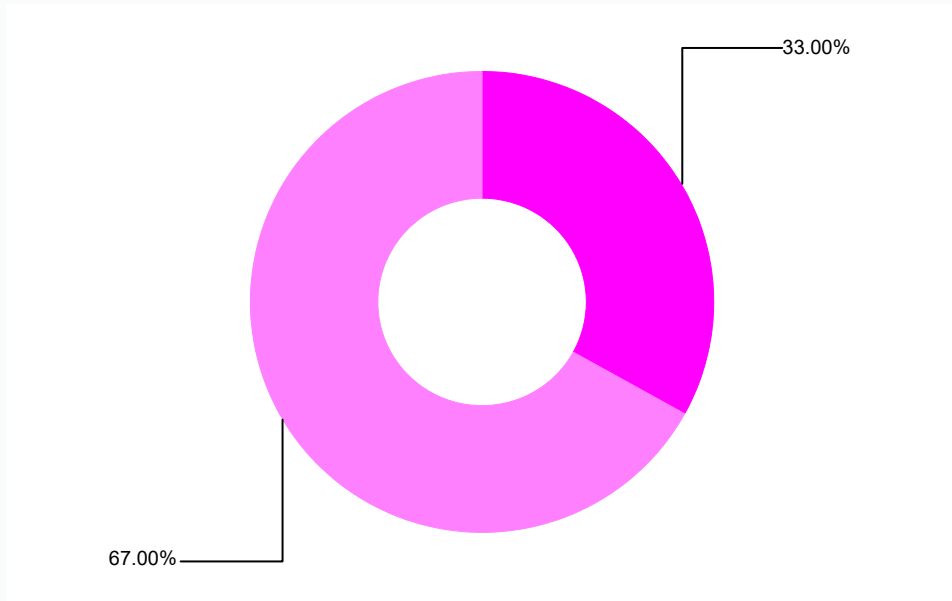

ABSTRACT REASONING



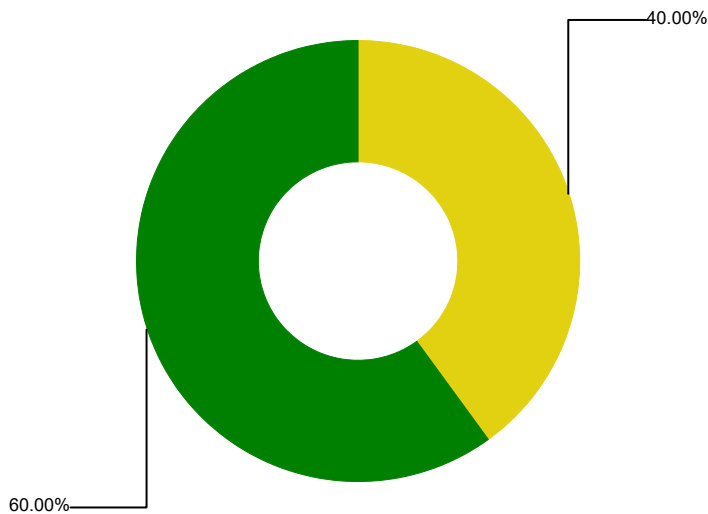

VERBAL REASONING



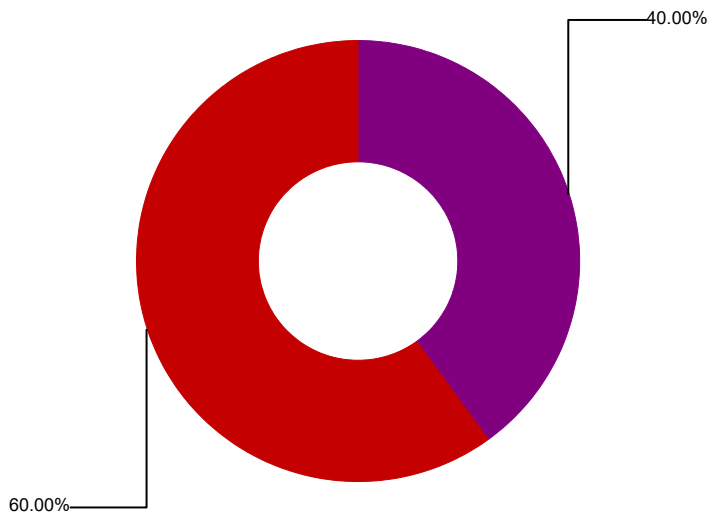

MECHANICAL REASONING



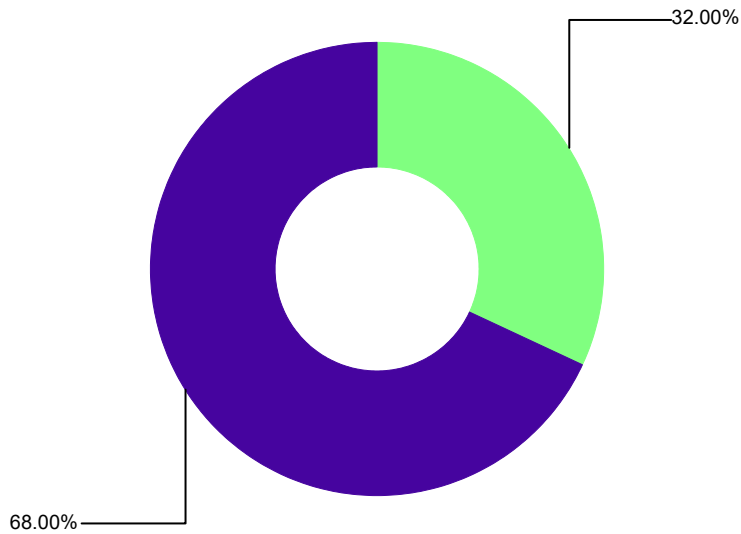

SPATIAL ABILITY



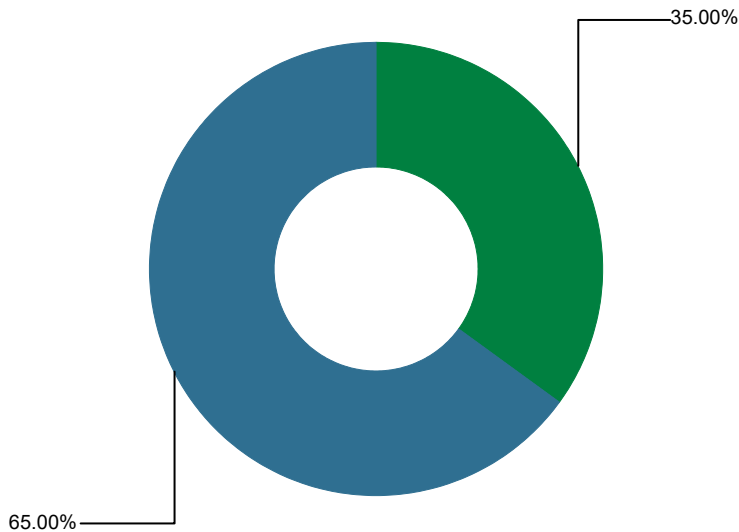

DIAGRAMMATIC REASONING



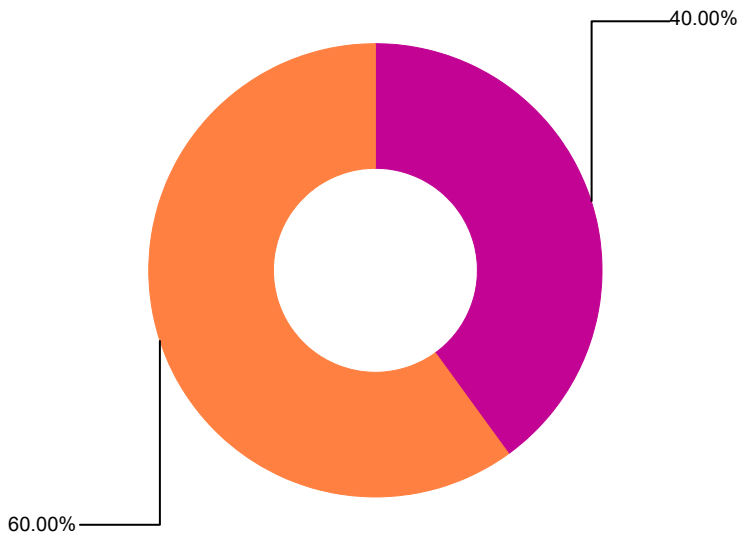

LOGICAL REASONING



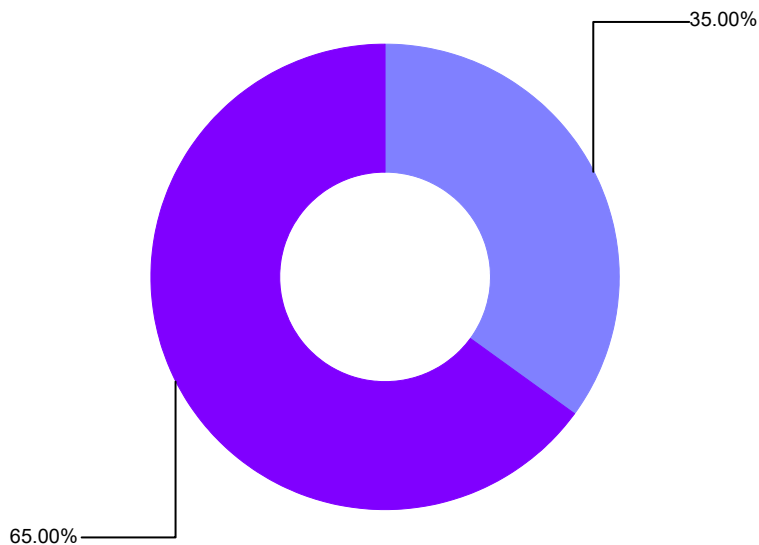

CRITICAL THINKING SKILLS



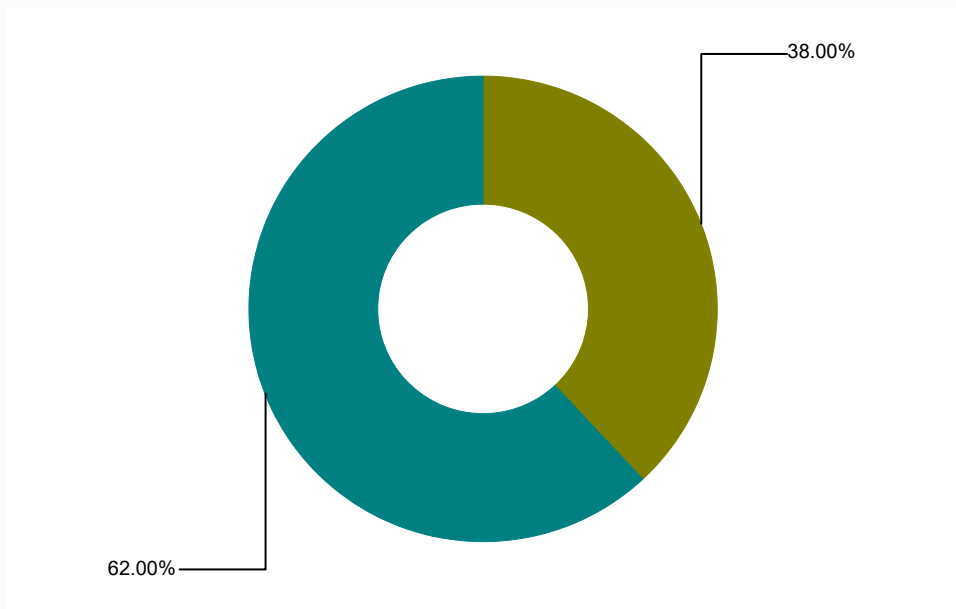

CREATIVITY SKILLS



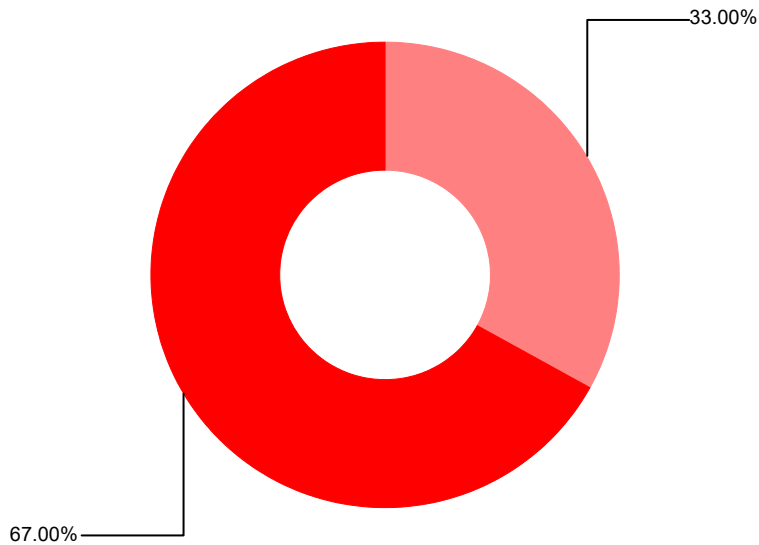

COMMUNICATION SKILLS



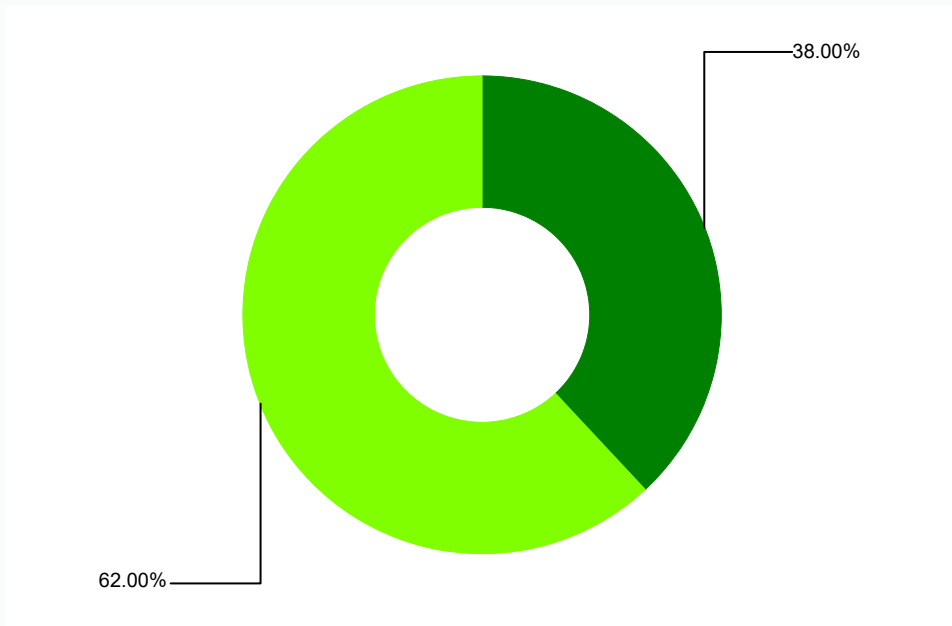

TECHNICAL SKILLS



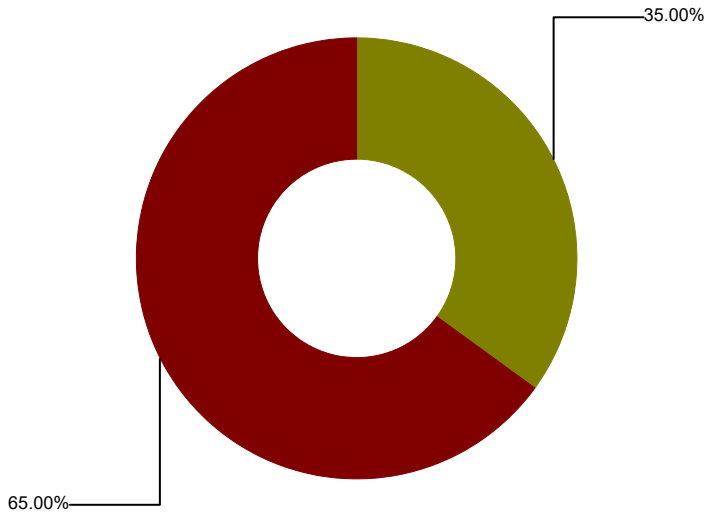
